

## AMBULANCE / FIRST RESPONDER MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT

Lac du Flambeau Ambulance/First Responder Service, known hereafter as  
(Name of Ambulance or First Responder Service)

Provider" hereby agrees to provide emergency mutual aid to Howard Young Medical  
Center Ambulance (dba Oneida Co EMS – HYMC) when requested through

the Vilas  
(Name of Sheriff or Dispatch Center) Dispatch Center or a direct call from another

ambulance/First Responder service; subject to having resources available to respond as  
requested.

Provider agrees to assist HYMC Ambulance in the following situations:

- Accidents and/or emergencies involving multiple victims which one service cannot adequately, and in a timely manner, handle with available resources.
- Two or more simultaneous emergencies within the service area that depletes the available resources.

Provider agrees not to charge the requesting entity, the Dispatch Center or HYMC  
ambulance for providing mutual aid service. Responding Providers reserve the right to  
bill patients transported by their service according to their own policies and fee  
schedules.

The parties agree that the rendering of assistance under this Agreement shall not affect  
the employment status of volunteers, nor shall it affect the duties or liabilities of either  
party. Each party agrees to assume liability imposed by law for the operation of its own  
vehicles and equipment, the acts of its own EMS personnel and equipment, and for the  
workers compensation benefits due its own Emergency Medical Technicians.

The parties agree nothing in this Agreement shall be construed to imply that any Provider  
has an obligation to furnish mutual aid if resources are otherwise committed to their  
primary service area.

This Agreement is effective \_\_\_\_\_, and shall continue on an ongoing  
basis unless otherwise terminated by the parties. Either party may terminate this  
agreement at any time, with or without cause, by providing the other party with ten (10)  
days written notice of termination.

## VILAS COUNTY FIRE DEPARTMENT

### MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT

This agreement made and entered into this 12 day of January, 2005, by and between all of the fire departments of Vilas County, and with the other municipalities, agencies, and organizations set forth herein, all of which are collectively referred to herein as the "Participants; " WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS it is the intention of the participants to cooperate and give mutual aid in the area of fire and rescue services in the future;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is agreed on behalf of the Participants, that mutual fire service will be provided in accordance with the below listed conditions:

1. Eligibility. Only those participants set forth herein shall be eligible which have and maintain or establish and maintain their own fire department.
2. Effective Date and Termination. This agreement shall be effective upon approval of this agreement by the governing body of the municipality or the appropriate officer with authority of the participant organization or agency. Only those participants which have approved this agreement and have provided signed and conformed copies of this agreement to the other participants will be able to participate. The agreements contained herein shall be effective immediately upon the adoption by the governing body and shall not terminate until sixty ( 60 ) days after the governing body of the municipality informs in writing the other participants of its decision to withdraw.
3. Rules and Regulations. The fire chief of each participant shall meet at a mutually convenient time and establish rules and regulations for the method of giving and receiving requests for service and equipment to be dispatched. The fire chiefs shall also establish the rules and regulations under which personnel and equipment will be deployed to fight fires or provide other services.
4. Automatic Aid. In the event of a structure fire automatic aid is provided in the following manner. This document instructs the Vilas Dispatch Center to page the department with jurisdiction and the next closest geographically adjacent department to provide automatic mutual aid for all reported structure fires.
5. Compensation. Mutual aid and fire service shall be rendered without charge to all member participants. Should any fee be requested by any municipality, it must be done so in advance and worked out between the municipalities in written agreement separate from this document.
6. Authorization. By signing this document, each participant authorizes its fire chief to render and request mutual aid, including rescue squad service, to the


other municipalities participating in the mutual aid agreement to the extent available personnel and equipment are not required for adequate protection of its own municipality. The judgment of the fire chief, or commanding officer in the chief's absence, as to the available amount of aid, personnel, or equipment shall be followed.


7. Liability. Each participant shall assume the liability imposed by law for the operation of its own vehicles and equipment, the acts of its own firefighters and equipment, and for the worker's compensation benefits due its own firefighters.
